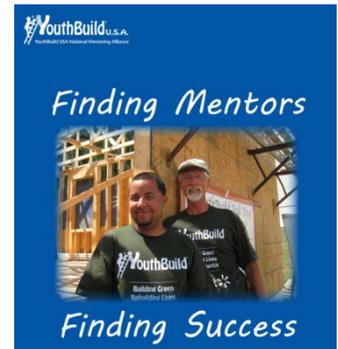


YouthBuild USA BRIDGE Resources

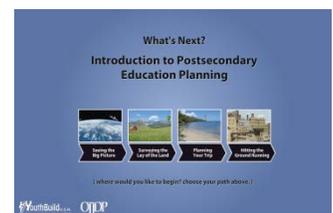

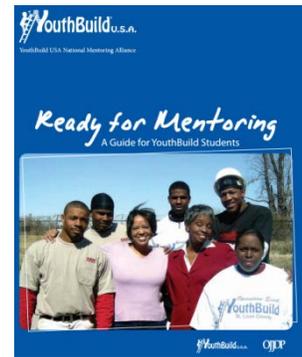

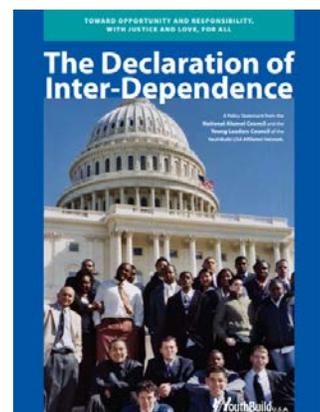
