Our teachers, Spoon Jackson and Judith Tanenbaum, pushed us to challenge ourselves to bring out the raw emotion of our hurt and pain even if this expression was hard for some to swallow. For me, having been in prison at the time for going on ten years, the hurt and pain was at an all-time high, not only from losing loved ones while in prison, which is a hurt that can barely be described, not being able to attend funerals or comfort one's relatives, also the frustrations of being Muslim in California's state prison system.
