[The Army and Navy During the Conquest of the Baltic Islands in October 1917](#) 1931 belgium was once described as the dagger held at the throat of england a collection of provinces that had long been a critical factor in british foreign policy and the traditional concern was that belgium and especially the flanders coast would fall into the hands of the strongest continental power in 1914 germany's occupation of belgium brought about the spectre of enemy ships only seventy miles from the british coast and the coast of flanders became effectively the naval flank of the western front admiral alfred von tirpitz was one of the few within the german navy who recognised the strategic potential of the three ports of ostend zeebrugge and brugges that they were closer to england than the helgoland bight for access by small craft and brought germany to within a few hours sailing of the thames estuary this new book tells the story of the creation purpose operations and career of the marinekorps flandern the flanders harbours should have allowed the german navy to strike dangerous blows at vital british traffic in the channel and southern north sea but the marinekorps was unable to fulfill the great expectations of von tirpitz the author not only explains how the german conducted operations but also explains how the opportunitites presented by the flemish occupation were wasted away a significant and insightful book on an important theatre of the war

[The Army and Navy During the Conquest of the Baltic Islands in October, 1917](#) 1936 after jutland analyses the naval war in northern european waters following the critical but inconclusive battle of jutland a popular misconception is that jutland marked the end of the operational career of the german high sea fleet and the beginning of a period of stagnation for both it and its opponent the grand fleet the reality is much more complex the german battle fleet was quiescent for much of the time in the north sea but it supported an ambitious amphibious campaign in the baltic while a bitter commerce war was waged by u boats and the light craft fought a grueling campaign in the waters of the english channel and the belgian coast after jutland focuses primarily on the royal navy as the dominant maritime force but it also analyses the struggles of the beleaguered german navy as it sought to find ways to break the tightening stranglehold of the blockade and undermine allied control of the world's oceans and of british home waters in particular the continuing conflict in the baltic will also be explored as the germans increased the pressure on the russian territory and the russian fleet while the latter despite its descent into revolution still struggled to provide an effective counter to the imperial german navy the royal navy learned much from jutland and applied those lessons to good effect it greatly improved the way that ships were organized for battle as well as developing new tactics there were also great leaps in communications and in command and control while both aviation and undersea operations including mine warfare developed at breakneck pace the imperial german navy made its own changes as a result of jutland indeed both germany and russia undertook much more naval innovation in the final years of the conflict than is often realized by 1918 all the protagonists were fighting what was in every way a multi dimensional maritime war that was the forerunner of naval conflict for the remainder of the twentieth century the period also saw the entry to the conflict of the united states and the increasing commitment of the united states navy usn units saw hard service before the armistice of november 1918 many of the foundations of success in the next war were laid by the usn at this time the learning curve was steep as officers and sailors alike sought to catch up on the experience of nearly three years of conflict but they brought new methods and new applications of technology to the operational problems with which their coalition partners had been struggling this included the sixth battle squadron which was rapidly assimilated into the grand fleet absorbing the hard won knowledge of their british colleagues but applying some of their own ideas

Historical Tactical Study 1937 the battle of jutland was the greatest naval engagement of the first world war if not any war admiral scheer had adopted a policy of launching attacks against the british coast what he did not know was that the british had broken his naval codes and that they knew of his plans consequently when scheer threw his entire fleet in a mission to attack the british mainland in may 1916 he could not know that the royal navy at scapa flow were underway this is a fresh account of this greatest naval engagement it offers fascinating insight into the events preceding the action the tactics during the battle and the political and military fall out the book draws on released official records and personal accounts jellicoe failed to ensnare scheer and the bulk of the german fleet which escaped battered but intact the germans knew however that despite their great fleet it was the royal navy that controlled the north sea

Translation of Vice-Admiral Schmidt's Despatch 1919 georg von rauch 1904 1991 was a baltic german historian specializing in russia and the baltic states rauch was born in pskov the son of kornelius von rauch who was serving in the russian army in 1911 the family moved to sangaste in southern estonia then part of the russian empire rauch graduated from the university of tartu with a degree in history in 1927 leaving for germany in 1939 he joined the staff of the university of marburg where he taught russian history in 1946 becoming a professor in 1953 in 1958 he accepted an offer from the university of kiel where he became head of the institute on east european history his pioneering history of the soviet union was translated into other languages and became a standard textbook his son was the anarchist georg von rauch killed by the police in 1971 wikipedia

Operation Albion 2008-02-19 in october 1917 an invasion force of some 25 000 german soldiers accompanied by a flotilla of 10 dreadnoughts 350 other vessels a half dozen zeppelins and 80 aircraft attacked the baltic islands of dago osel and moon at the head of the gulf of riga it proved to be the most successful amphibious operation of world war i the three islands fell the gulf was opened to german warships and was now a threat to russian naval bases in the gulf of finland and 20 000 russians were captured the invasion proved to be the last major operation in the east although the invasion had achieved its objectives and placed the germans in an excellent position for the resumption of warfare in the spring within three weeks of the operation the bolsheviks took power in russia november 7 1917 and albion faded into obscurity as the war in the east came to a slow end

[The Conquest of the Baltic Islands September-October 1917](#) 1937 the translation of these memoirs brings an important and authoritative historical source to those interested in russian or naval history who are unable to access them in the original russian their author rear admiral s n timiryov was well placed to make observations on the character of many of the significant commanding officers and also many of the operations of the baltic fleet from the beginning of the war in 1914 up to exit from it in 1918 he trained with many of the key figures and shared battle experience with them in the russo japanese war of 1904 05 and the siege of port arthur and he spent a year in japan as a prisoner of war with a number of them in his subsequent career in the navy he had roles which brought him into contact with new recruits as well as with many serving officers and as the executive officer on the imperial yacht shtandart for some years he came into contact with senior members of the navy establishment and of the government including the imperial household his memoirs also exhibit an unusual degree of self awareness written in shanghai in 1922 these memoirs remained unknown to scholars for several decades since their publication in new york in 1961 in the absence of access to authoritative archives many historians in the west used them as a source for the study of the role of the navy in the russian revolution particularly as it unfolded in the north they have also been used as a source in numerous studies of the naval war in the baltic and following the fall of the soviet union they were re published in russia and are regarded there as an authoritative source on the history both of the revolution and of the russian navy in the first world war this first english language edition complemented by extensive notes and commentary on issues which may not be familiar to many will fascinate scholars and naval historians alike

Skagerrak 2016-05-04 there have been a number of studies published on the activities of british and german navies during world war i but little on naval action in other arenas this book offers for the first time a balanced history of the naval war as a whole viewed from the perspective of all participants in all major theaters the author's earlier examination the naval war in the mediterranean 1914 1918 centered on submarine activities and allied efforts to counteract this new menace with this welcome sequel he again takes the reader beyond those world war i operations staged on the north sea halpern's clear and authoritative voice lends a cohesiveness to this encompassing view of the italians and austrians in the adriatic the russians germans and turks in the baltic and black seas and french and british in the mediterranean important riverine engagements notably on the danube also are included along with major colonial campaigns such as mesopotamia and the dardanelles the role of neutral sea powers such as the swedes in the baltic and the dutch in the east indies is examined from the perspective of how their neutrality affected naval activity also discussed is the part played by the u s navy and the often overlooked but far from negligible role of the japanese navy the latter is viewed in the context of the opening months of the war and in the mediterranean during the height of the submarine crisis of 1917

[Battle for the Baltic Islands, 1917](#) 2009-03-09 a very detailed operational account of the highly successful german amphibious landings in october of 1917 on the russian islands of osel and dago the nymas review in late 1917 the russians despite the revolution were still willing to continue the war against germany this is an account of operation albion the highly successful seaborne operation launched by the germans to change their minds the baltic islands were pivotal for the defense of the finnish gulf and st petersburg so their capture was essential for any campaign towards the russian capital only after the fall of the islands did russia begin peace negotiations freeing nearly half a million german soldiers for the kaiser s last gamble on the western front this then was a campaign of great significance for the war on both eastern and western fronts a large part of the high sea fleet took part in the invasion of the baltic islands including the most modern dreadnought battleships the russians mounted a resolute defense despite being heavily outgunned and over a ten day period there were many naval clashes around the islands as well as the campaign ashore all of which are described in detail with the use of both russian and german firsthand accounts this book shatters the myth that the imperial german navy spent the last two years of the war cowering in port should be a blueprint for other military history books the maps are some of the best i have seen in military books the author tells the story of the campaign from the smallest mine sweeper to the various battleships involved a wargamers needful things

[The Taking of the Baltic Islands in October, 1917](#) 1930 in january 1916 vizeadmiral scheer took command of the high sea fleet this aggressive and pugnacious leader embarked upon a vigorous offensive program which culminated in the greatest clash between dreadnought capital ships the world had seen although outnumbered almost two to one vizeadmiral scheer conducted a provocative operation on 31 may 1916 who would prevail the massive preponderance of british heavy calibre cannon or the aggressive tactics of the street fighter scheer manning the ships of both sides were the technically skilled and talented seamen who were prepared to carry out their duties loyally and courageously until the very end over 8 500 men perished in less than 10 hours of fighting a horrendous loss even by world war one standards this book gives voice to many of the german navy participants from a german perspective on this tumultuous battle fought over 100 years ago these men gave their all and are gone now but not forgotten

After Jutland 2018-10-15 this is the first study of the ludendorff offensives of 1918 based extensively on key german records presumed to be lost forever after potsdam was bombed in 1944 in 1997 david t zabecki discovered translated copies of these files in a collection of old instructional material at the u s army command and general staff college at fort leavenworth kansas he presents his findings here for the first time with a thorough review of the surviving original operational plans and orders to offer a wealth of fresh insights to the german offensives of 1918 david t zabecki clearly demonstrates how the german failure to exploit the vulnerabilities in the bef s rail system led to the failure of the first two offensives and how inadequacies in the german rail system determined the outcome of the last three offensives this is a window into the mind of the german general staff of world war i with thorough analysis of the german planning and decision making processes during the execution of battles this is also the first study in english or in german to analyze the specifics of the aborted operation hagen plan this is also the first study of the 1918 offensives to focus on the operational level of war and on the body of military activity known as the operational art rather than on the conventional tactical or strategic levels this book will be of great interest to all students of world war i the german army and of strategic studies and military theory in general
