feb 12 2021 leonardo da vinci s inexhaustible portrait of lisa del giocondo the 24 year old mother of five and wife of a wealthy florentine silk merchant who sat for the high renaissance master in 1503 is the mona lisa ,moʊnə 'li:sə moh nə lee sə italian gioconda dʒo'konda or monna lisa 'monna 'li:za french joconde ʒokɔ̃ d is a half length portrait painting by italian artist leonardo da vinci the mona lisa is a likely a portrait of the wife of a florentine merchant for some reason however the portrait was never delivered to its patron and leonardo kept it with him when he went to work for francis i the king of france the mona lisa set the standard for all future portraits the painting presents a woman revealed in the 21st century to likely have been lisa del giocondo the wife of the florentine merchant francesco del giocondo hence the alternative title to the work la gioconda the picture presents a half body portrait of the subject with a distant leonardo da vinci portrait of lisa gherardini known as the mona lisa c 1503 19 oil on poplar panel 77 x 53 cm musée du louvre paris the mona lisa s mysterious smile has inspired many writers singers and painters mona lisa oil painting on a poplar wood panel by leonardo da vinci probably the world s most famous painting the sitter s mysterious smile and her unproven identity have made the work a source of ongoing investigation and fascination read more about the painting s subject and history the mona lisa is an oil painting by italian artist inventor and writer leonardo da vinci likely completed in 1506 the piece features a portrait of a seated woman set against an imaginary landscape in addition to being one of the mona lisa renaissance iconic masterpiece the influence of the mona lisa on the renaissance and later times has been enormous revolutionizing contemporary portrait painting one of the most iconic and recognizable paintings in the world is the mona lisa ca 1503 1519 painted by leonardo da vinci the unique appeal of the portrait lies in its enigmatic nature mona lisa s smile radiates mystery sensuality and contentment sep 8 2023 five centuries after leonardo da vinci painted the mona lisa 1503 19 the portrait hangs behind bulletproof glass within the louvre museum and draws thousands of jostling spectators each day it is the most famous painting in the world and yet when viewers manage to see the artwork up close they are likely to be baffled by the small
