Licensing and registration under the Animal Welfare Act 1913 federal ground depicts the haphazard and unplanned growth of federal authority in the northwest and southwest territories the first u s territories established under the new territorial system the nation s foundational documents particularly the constitution and the northwest ordinance placed these territories under sole federal jurisdiction and established federal officials to govern them but for all their paper authority these officials rarely controlled events or dictated outcomes in practice power in these contested borderlands rested with the regions pre existing inhabitants diverse native peoples french villagers and anglo american settlers these residents nonetheless turned to the new federal government to claim ownership jurisdiction protection and federal money seeking to obtain rights under federal law two areas of governance proved particularly central contests over property where plural sources of title created conflicting land claims and struggles over the right to use violence in which customary borderlands practice intersected with the federal government s effort to establish a monopoly on force over time as federal officials improvised ad hoc largely extrajudicial methods to arbitrate residents claims they slowly insinuated federal authority deeper into territorial life this authority survived even after the former territories became tennessee and ohio although these new states spoke a language of equal footing and autonomy statehood actually offered former territorial citizens the most effective way yet to make claims on the federal government the federal government in short still could not always prescribe the result in the territories but it set the terms and language of debate authority that became the foundation for later more familiar and bureaucratic incarnations of federal power

Dynamics of Ownership in the Alpine Context 2016-07-29 an argument for retaining the notion of personal property in the products we buy in the digital marketplace if you buy a book at the bookstore you own it you can take it home scribble in the margins put in on the shelf lend it to a friend sell it at a garage sale but is the same thing true for the ebooks or other digital goods you buy retailers and copyright holders argue that you don't own those purchases you merely license them that means your ebook vendor can delete the book from your device without warning or explanation as amazon deleted orwell's 1984 from the kindles of surprised readers several years ago these readers thought they owned their copies of 1984 until it turned out they didn't in the end of ownership aaron perzanowski and jason schultz explore how notions of ownership have shifted in the digital marketplace and make an argument for the benefits of personal property of course ebooks cloud storage streaming and other digital goods offer users convenience and flexibility but perzanowski and schultz warn consumers should be aware of the tradeoffs involving user constraints permanence and privacy the rights of private property are clear but few people manage to read their end user agreements perzanowski and schultz argue that introducing aspects of private property and ownership into the digital marketplace would offer both legal and economic benefits but most important it would affirm our sense of self direction and autonomy if we own our purchases we are free to make whatever lawful use of them we please technology need not constrain our freedom it can also empower us
