optimal financial management of government resources by ensuring that spending agencies are provided in a timely manner the resources needed for a smooth provision of public services while minimizing the cost of government financing however international experience shows that agencies that go by the same name the treasury assume a variety of responsibilities within the gamut of functions encompassed by government financial management this paper argues that in countries facing substantial economic and financial adjustment

problems and or rapid institutional change it is desirable to give the treasury a broader rather than narrower range of responsibilities in government financial management this is typically the case in economies in transition in which under central planning treasury functions were dispersed among different agencies including the central bank the paper presents an overview of the main issues governments are likely to face in setting up a national treasury in particular in economies in transition it begins with an analysis of the main treasury functions it then
