drove in movies those he owned and others he raced with a foreword by steve s son chad mcqueen and a wealth of details about of the star s racing career stunt work and car and motorcycle collecting mcqueen s machines draws a fascinating picture of one outsized man s driving passion now in paperback in 1982 at the age of just twenty three and halfway through her architecture studies elspeth beard left her family and friends in london and set off on a 35 000 mile solo adventure around the world on her 1974 bmw r60 6 reeling from a recent breakup and with only limited savings from her pub job a tent a few clothes and

some tools all packed on the back of her bike she was determined to prove herself she had ridden bikes since her teens and was well travelled but nothing could prepare her for what lay ahead when she returned to london nearly two and a half years later she was stones lighter and decades wiser she d ridden through unforgiving landscapes and countries ravaged by war witnessed civil uprisings that forced her to fake documents and fended off sexual attacks biker gangs and corrupt police convinced she was trafficking drugs she d survived life threatening illnesses personal loss and brutal accidents that had left permanent scars and a

black hole in her memory and she d fallen in love with two very different men in an age before email the internet mobile phones satnavs and in some parts of the world readily available and reliable maps elspeth achieved something that would still seem remarkable today told with honesty and wit this is the extraordinary and moving story of a unique and life changing adventure this is a true story about a special relationship that developed between a wild desert bird and the owner and friends of a special house in the western mojave in california if you have ever looked into the eyes of a wild animal especially in its natural habitat you know

how special that moment can be anyone with a family pet knows the special bond between animal and man and it can be a truly amazing experience in fact most pet owners consider their animals to be an integral part of the family and include them in weddings rely on them for protection and grieve upon their demise having an untamed animal not only approach you but maintain a constant presence throughout its life was transformative for me and became a defining part of my life it is a story that is best shared and will hopefully enrich yours as well even the most hands on of classic bike enthusiasts will often shy away
