2009-06-05 the code of hammurabi is a well preserved babylonian law code of ancient mesopotamia

dating back to about 1754 bc it is one of the oldest deciphered writings of significant length in the world the sixth babylonian king hammurabi enacted the code and partial copies exist on a man sized stone stele and various clay tablets the code consists of 282 laws with scaled punishments adjusting an eye for an eye a tooth for a tooth lex talionis as graded depending on social status of slave versus free man nearly one half of the code deals with matters of contract establishing for example the wages to be paid to an ox driver or a surgeon other provisions set the terms of a transaction establishing the

liability of a builder for a house that collapses for example or property that is damaged while left in the care of another a third of the code addresses issues concerning household and family relationships such as inheritance divorce paternity and sexual behavior only one provision appears to impose obligations on an official this provision establishes that a judge who reaches an incorrect decision is to be fined and removed from the bench permanently a few provisions address issues related to military service hammurabi ruled for nearly 42 years c 1792 to 1750 bc according to the
