the migrants themselves who were responsible for the strength or weakness of welsh religious life the success or failure of welsh cultural institutions they who decided whether or not to retain and transmit their national language if indeed they spoke it in the first place they who chose whether or not to marry within their own group to live amongst their own to retain the ties of welshness and pass on the values of the old country or to attempt full and immediate integration they who were miners or shop owners abstainers or drunkards law abiding or criminal a true picture of welsh immigrant life can only be obtained by considering the community in its entirety to view it in the round as it were this work attempts to do just that and hopes to make some small contribution to the understanding of what it was to be one amongst the thousands of welsh people who lived in a particular place at a certain time in a land so far from wales the earl of stonegate called the devil of the ton and the earl of blackvale known as the debonair of the ton have a few things in common they are both wealthy dashing enough to make women swoon and they both want each other the problem is neither of them wants to surrender to the other and instead of settling the matter with a duel they decide to hold a contest which of them can seduce the lovely but plain lady agnes may the best gentleman win warning this 4614 word about 23 pages short story is a steamy read that features explicit scenes including bisexual and threesome content in a historical victorian era setting and may be too much for some readers to handle bridging two peoples tells the story of dr peter e jones who in 1866 became one of the first status indians to obtain a medical doctor degree from a canadian university he returned to his southern ontario reserve and was elected chief and band doctor as secretary to the grand indian council of ontario he became a bridge between peoples conveying the chiefs concerns to his political mentor prime minister sir john a macdonald most importantly during consultations on the indian act the third son of a mississauga ojibwe missionary

and his English wife Peter E. Jones overcame paralytic polio to lead his people forward. He supported the granting of voting rights to Indians and edited Canada's first Native newspaper to encourage them to vote. He appointed a federal Indian agent, a post usually reserved for non-Natives. Jones promoted education and introduced modern public health measures on his reserve, but there was little he could do to stem the ravages of tuberculosis that cemetery records show claimed upwards of 40 per cent of the band. The Jones family included Native and non-Native members who treated each other equally. Jones's Mississauga grandmother is now honoured for helping survey the province of Ontario. His mother published books and his wife was an early feminist. The appendix describes how Aboriginal grandmothers used herbal medicines and crafted surgical appliances from birchbark. This is a tale about wide open relationships and wide open legs as two men and one woman spend one wild night exploring their sexuality.
