Martin Luther King, Jr. 2000-09 in january 1942 soviet press photographers came upon a scene like none they had ever documented that day they took pictures of the first liberation of a german mass atrocity where an estimated 7 000 jews and others were executed at an anti tank trench near kerch on the crimean peninsula dmitri baltermants a photojournalist working for the soviet newspaper izvestiia took photos that day that would have a long life in shaping the image of nazi genocide in and against the soviet union presenting never before seen photographs grief the biography of a holocaust photograph shows how baltermants used the image of a grieving woman to render this gruesome mass atrocity into a transcendently human tragedy david shneer tells the story of how that one photograph from the series baltermants took that day in 1942 near kerch became much more widely known than the others eventually being titled grief baltermants turned this shocking wartime atrocity photograph into a cold war era artistic meditation on the profundity and horror of war that today can be found in holocaust photo archives as well as in art museums and at art auctions although the journalist documented murdered jews in other pictures he took at kerch in grief there are likely no jews among the dead or the living save for the possible nkvd soldier securing the site nonetheless shneer shows that this photograph must be seen as an iconic holocaust photograph unlike images of emaciated camp survivors or barbed wire fences shneer argues the holocaust by bullets in the soviet union make grief a quintessential soviet image of nazi genocide

Harriet Tubman 1998-09 abraham lincoln stood out in a crowd as much for his wit and rollicking humor as for his height this newbery medal winning biography of our civil war president is warm appealing and illustrated with dozens of carefully chosen photographs and prints russell freedman begins with a lively account of abraham lincoln s boyhood his career as a country lawyer and his courtship and marriage to mary todd then the author focuses on the presidential years 1861 to 1865 skillfully explaining the many complex issues lincoln grappled with as he led a deeply divided nation through the civil war the book s final chapter is a moving account of that tragic evening in ford s theatre on april 14 1865 concludes with a sampling of lincoln writings and a detailed list of lincoln historical sites this title has been selected as a common core text exemplar grades 2 3 read aloud informational text

Sojourner Truth 1997 a brief biography of booker t washington the man who was born a slave and went on to become a national leader for the education of african americans and the founder of tuskegee institute

Elizabeth Cady Stanton 1998 in 1877 in rochester new york george eastman couldn t understand why picture taking was so difficult having left school at fourteen to support his mother and two sisters george decided to find out by making photography his hobby he packed up glass plates a plate holder a tent a heavy tripod a thick piece of black cloth a water jug and chemicals and set off to take his first photograph george realized that not many people could own a camera they were too expensive and the size of today s microwave ovens but how could he make picture taking easier eventually george created dry plates and they were such a success that he opened his own dry plate company in 1881 but this was only the beginning george went on to invent film and the brownie camera the rest is history monica kulling s spunky playful text is beautifully complemented by the stunning pen and ink with watercolor illustrations of artist bill slavin it s a snap george eastman s first photo introduces a new series for tundra the great idea series a must have for schools libraries and parents alike

Franz Liszt 1968 this striking compilation of almost 300 photographs offers a profound insight into the life and work of mahatma gandhi 1869 1948 as both a public figure and a private individual it embodies a precious and intimate view of a side to gandhi s life with which many are not as familiar through a perspective that is at once pragmatic and personal this book pursues a compelling visual narrative and permits us a very rare and highly privileged understanding of gandhi given via a diverse range of photographic lenses from the witty and ardent press to the sensitive and intelligent agency and the ingenuous eye of a great nephew many of these images have never been seen before they are derived from two essential and exclusive collections the photo archives of gandhi s foremost biographer vithalbhai jhaveri and those of kanu gandhi gandhi s great nephew after jhaveri s death peter rühe assimilated the extensive photo collection of over 9 000 prints into a photo archive of the highest standard using scientific cataloguing and computerization the second photographic source that of kanu gandhi is especially breathtaking because of its history kanu gandhi lived with mahatma gandhi for the last 12 years of the latter s life he was the sole person by whom gandhi consented to be photographed and even so only on three conditions that the freedom movement would not fund them that there was to be no use of flash and that gandhi would not pose for him in rühe s book gandhi s extraordinary life is brought to light by means of this astounding collection of images the pictures in this compilation are also unique in that they follow gandhi all the way from his early life in india to his law studies in london his work in south africa and finally his return to lead the struggle for indian independence which won him the title father of the nation in india a magnificent accomplishment in itself this volume identifies the encompassing sweep of world politics and the perpetual struggles of the poor with the life of a single individual whose impact on the world is matched by few in the history of mankind
