felt in cases related to federalism economic rights and affirmative action however liberal issues such as abortion have moved only marginally to the right while rulings by the court on school prayer and gay rights have moved constitutional doctrine slightly to the left in this collection of original articles prominent constitutional scholars are joined by new voices from the cutting edge of academia to subject the rehnquist court to closer scrutiny and to show that its brand of conservatism is less extreme than many have supposed reflecting views across the political spectrum the contributors help readers understand the court dynamic its constrained conservatism and the forces that shape constitutional law in general as these authors show the overall pattern of decision-making in the rehnquist era cannot be attributed to any single unified approach to constitutional analysis instead today's court can only be understood as the product of a complex interaction among individual justices each with an idiosyncratic view of the proper interpretation of the constitution and the role of the court in the american political system these provocative essays are designed to
