cycles in the united states minority groups african americans hispanics mainly mexicans and central americans east asians chinese japanese koreans philippinos and south asians indians pakistanis and bengalis have significantly lower chances of live births compared to caucasian women birth outcome data collected by the society for assisted reproductive technology shows a worsening trend in conception rates between the years 1999 2000 and 2004 2006 raising more concern that the disparity in fertility rates between minority groups and white women is widening over time this comprehensive
