foreign direct investment in the united states in 2015 increased by 83 over that recorded in 2014 note the united states defines foreign direct investment as the ownership or control directly or indirectly by one foreign person individual branch partnership association government etc of 10 or more of the voting securities of an incorporated u s business enterprise or an equivalent interest in an unincorporated u s business enterprise on october 31 2013 the obama administration launched a new initiative known as select usa to attract more foreign direct investment to the united states according to the administration the aim of the program is to make attracting foreign investment as important a component of u s foreign policy as promoting exports as a result the president reportedly instructed commerce and state department officials to make attracting foreign investment one of their core priorities in addition the program has designated global teams led by u s ambassadors in 32 key countries to encourage foreign investment into the united states and has established a coordinated process to connect prospective investors with senior u s officials the initiative selectusa commerce gov offers a number of tools for foreign investors looking to invest in the united states including a list of various state and federal programs that may be available to foreign investors some of the most populated and storied american cities had mayoral elections in 2013 open contests in new york city los angeles and boston for example offer laboratories to examine electoral trends in urban politics cities are facing varied predicaments boston was rocked by the bombing of the marathon on april 15 detroit is roiled by being the largest u s city to declare bankruptcy and chicago which had an open competitive election in 2011 is dealing with significant gun violence san diego s mayor resigned in august 2013 due to sexual harassment charges and other mayors are surrounded by corruption scandals houston and st louis had non competitive elections recently but their mayors are notable for their tenure in office and emphasis will be on public policy outcomes in those cases leaders in most cities face dramatic changes and challenges due to economic and social realities the keys to city hall offers a complete and succinct review and analysis of the top mayoral campaigns in major american cities in recent years as well as the politics and public policy management of those urban areas emerging theories of urban governance demographic changes and economic conditions are examined in introductory chapters the introduction will provide a unique and comprehensive focus on major trends in advertisement changes in campaign strategies fundraising and the use of social media at the local level in part two scholars with expertise in local politics urban public policy and the governance explore some of the largest and most noteworthy u s cities each of which has a recent competitive mayoral election they will also provide updated data on mayoral powers and problems faced by local executives written as lively narratives in a highly readable style this book advances theory on urban politics by reviewing developments in the field and aligning theoretical approaches with realities on the ground based on the most recent elections and governance structures as such it will be a much needed resource to scholars interested in local politics and the public policy debates of specific major urban and metropolitan areas the urban data management society has organised international symposia at various locations throughout europe since 1971 and udms 2013 marks its second visit to london from its outset udms has highlighted changes and trends in urban data and urban data management however the rate of emergence of new data and new technologies has never been as rapid as it is now trends including smart cities smart phones social media 3d modelling volunteered geographic information building information modelling and the internet of things all generate information about the urban environment and the people who live there additionally the volume of data generated in part through such techniques has in turn resulted in research into big data how best to handle the data analyse it visualise it in different contexts thus the challenges and opportunities facing those working with these new types of urban data are manifold given this the general theme for udms 2013 was recent and emerging trends in the management of new urban data this book contains 20 papers selected from the long papers that were submitted for udms 2013 each paper was reviewed by three independent academic reviewers from around the world both for academic quality and for clarity in communication the book is intended to be suitable for different readers from city planners and architects to academics students and policy makers and those involved in urban planning political leadership at the local level has attracted growing

attention in recent years in parallel with reforms of local government and of the municipal administration as well as the debate on a shift from government to governance but this debate is mainly focused on single leaders i e mayors or executive officers considering the power triangle of i the mayor ii the municipal administration executive officers and iii the council it is surprising that councillors have gained little interest so far the aim of this book is to reflect on the role and task perception as well as the behaviour of councillors in the changing context of local democracy the chapters start from a common conceptual framework we start from the hypothesis that the role perception as well as the behaviour of councillors can not be conceived of being determined directly by i both formals and informal institutional structures as well as by ii personal characteristics instead we argue that the perceptions and behaviour of councillors are depending on their notion of democracy however the understanding of democracy can be affected by institutional structure but not solely by such organisational arrangements but depending on personal characteristics of the focus on black governed municipalities and make comparisons of expenditure patterns to the group as a whole decennial census and census of government data collected since 1960 provide the source for more than 75 variables describe population composition size governance attributes revenue sources and related variables and constructs a favorable reputation is an asset of importance that no public
