and considerate towards others to pursue this course i wish i were more competent to the task i have undertaken but i trust my readers will excuse deficiencies in consideration of circumstances i was born and reared in slavery and i remained in a slave state twenty seven years since i have been at the north it has been necessary for me to work diligently for my own support and the education of my children this has not left me much leisure to make up for the loss of early opportunities to improve myself and it has compelled me to write these pages at irregular intervals whenever i could snatch an hour from household duties this work has been selected by scholars as being culturally important and is part of the knowledge base of civilization as we know it this work is in the public domain in appreciation society in which a key activity is wearing paper horns sometimes this results in a fire that's what happens when a lightbulb wears a paper horn but when they meet their first real live rhino and ask her to do rhino things she doesn't want to charge or snort she's a gardener she is not what the society expected but can they learn to appreciate her for who she is this funny character driven story explores themes of friendship expectations and prejudice the voice of Harriet Taylor Mill is a work about collaboration Harriet's life with her lover friends and members of her family Harriet's joint work with John Stuart Mill and the author's interaction with the reader Jo Ellen Jacobs explores and expands the concept of biography using Salman Rushdie's analogy of history as a process of chutnification she gives Harriet's life shape and form that is to say meaning in a way that will possess the authentic taste of truth in the first chapter the first 30 years of Harriet's life are presented in the format of a first person diary one not actually written by HTM herself the text is based on letters and historical context but the style suggests the intimate experience of reading someone's journal the second chapter continues the chronological account of HTM until her death in 1858 in an interlude between the first and second chapters Jacobs pauses to explore Harriet's life with John Stuart Mill and in the final chapter she argues persuasively that Harriet and John collaborated extensively on many works including *On Liberty* a comprehensive and moving biography of Max Jacob a brilliant cubist poet who lived at the margins of fame though less of a household name than his contemporaries in early twentieth century Paris Jewish homosexual poet Max Jacob was Pablo Picasso's initiator into French culture Guillaume Apollinaire's guide out of the haze of symbolism and Jean Cocteau's loyal friend as Picasso reinvented painting Jacob helped to reinvent poetry with compressed hard edged prose poems and synapse skipping verse lyrics the product of a complex amalgamation of Jewish Breton Parisian and Roman Catholic influences in Max Jacob the poet's life plays out against the vivid backdrop of bohemian Paris from the turn of the twentieth century through the divisions of World War II acclaimed poet Rosanna Warren transports us to Picasso's ramshackle studio in Montmartre where cubism was born introduces the artists gathered at a seedy bar on the left bank where Max would often hold court and offers a front row seat to the artistic squabbles that shaped the modernist movement Jacob's complex understanding of faith art and sexuality animates this sweeping work in 1909 he saw a vision of Christ in his shabby room in Montmartre and in 1915 he converted formally from Judaism to Catholicism with Picasso as his godfather in his later years Jacob split his time between Paris and the monastery of Benoît-sur-Loire in February 1944 he was arrested by the Gestapo and sent to Drancy where he would die a few days later more than thirty years in the making this landmark biography offers a compelling tragic portrait of Jacob as a man and as an artist alongside a rich study of his groundbreaking poetry in Warren's own stunning translations Max Jacob is a nuanced deeply researched and essential contribution to modernist scholarship a defense of Capt Cresap contradicting the statements made by T. Jefferson in his notes on the state of Virginia and J.
