a texas oilman a brilliant female archaeologist an unknown world underneath the vatican in 1939 a team of workers beneath the vatican unearthed an early christian grave this surprising discovery launched a secret quest that would last decades a quest to discover the long lost burial place of the apostle peter from earliest times christian tradition held that peter a lowly fisherman from galilee whom christ made leader of his

church was executed in rome by emperor nero and buried on vatican hill but his tomb had been lost to history now funded anonymously by a wealthy american a small army of workers embarked on the dig of a lifetime the incredible sometimes shocking story of the 75 year search and its key players has never been fully told until now the quest would pit one of the 20th century s most talented archaeologists a woman against top vatican insiders the fisherman s tomb is a story of the triumph of faith and genius against all odds about the author john o neill is a lawyer and 1 new york times bestselling author he has spent much of his life visiting and researching early christian sites he is a 1967 graduate of the naval academy a former law clerk to supreme court chief justice william rehnquist and senior partner at a large international law firm a fascinating and thorough account of the egyptian process of mummification and efforts to safeguard places of burial against thieves originally published in 1946 this book presents r c trevelyan s english metrical translation of sophocles oedipus at colonus the translation was based upon the text published by sir richard claverhouse jebb in 1900 a short introduction by trevelyan is also included this book will be of value to anyone with an interest in english translations of ancient greek drama and the works of sophocles this is the first full translation of marino sanudo torsello s *secreta fidelium crucis* to be made into english the work itself is a piece of crusading propaganda following the fall of acre in 1291 written between 1300 and 1321 but it includes much of historical relevance along with interesting observations on the early history of jerusalem and the crusader kingdom the translation is based upon the text edited by jacques bongars in 1611 there is an introduction that contextualises the book its author his sources and his audience the notes provide essential information to clarify internal textual references and allusions as well as the role of biblical references in sanudo s grand design the index is designed to make this detailed text usable and accessible in this his major work sanudo advocated the conquest of egypt as the means to regain jerusalem for the latins and worked through his points with considerable

detail alongside references to 13th century mediterranean history especially involving louis ix of france and charles of anjou king of naples books i and ii give considerable detailed discussion of the concept plan and costs of his proposed crusade book iii provides an outline history of the crusades and the crusader states it is derived from a wide reading of other sources especially of william of tyre and for events after 1184 on the eracles the letters of james of vitry and sanudo s own experiences in the east throughout the work contains a staggering amount of cartographical ethnographical geographical and nautical information as well as numerous unique insights into historical events and personalities of the late 13th century not only in outremer but in western europe the first book to present the true identity of the mythic figure merlin uncovers historical evidence that the legend of merlin was based on the life of a real man reveals that avalon merlin s final resting place was an island in the united states the legendary figure merlin is known throughout the world as the wizard of camelot who was counselor to king arthur and helped that monarch create the round table through the course of a 20 year investigation graham phillips has uncovered evidence that this famous story was based on the life of an actual historical figure the son of a roman consul who became the last of the romans to rule britain in the fifth century a d furthermore the evidence reveals that he died and was buried in what is now the united states according to legend merlin ended his life on the mystical island of avalon a 1500 year old saga tells how merlin left britain on a boat bound for a mysterious island to the west the places described in merlin s voyage phillips argues would only have been seen by someone who had journeyed to the new world for example the island where boiling fountains bubble from the ground could be the geysers of iceland and the island with rivers of ice the glaciers of greenland during his research phillips discovered that a site believed to be merlin s grave was found by the first british settlers in north america a secret location said to have been preserved in the works of william shakespeare and the coded writings of the freemasons phillips follows a
