in border control work the final findings reveal that the schengen co operation suffers from a deficiency of transparency and proportionality consequently measures are proposed to augment the deficiency even as this study was reaching its conclusion fundamental legislative changes closely similar to some of the arguments and recommendations projected in this study took place the efficacy of these changes is yet to be discerned acknowledging that member state governments believe that the european community does not have competence to formulate refugee policy this paper

provides the author s opinion on how ec policies may be shaped to conform to existing international refugee obligations including the european convention on human rights a review of the work of the trevi group is presented and questions are raised about the group s recommendations concerning visa requirements listing of undesirable foreigners and the application of sanctions to transporters of foreigners without correct travel documents of primary concern to the author is the potential for abuse of the schengen agreement of 1985 which was signed between the benelux states france and west germany and has as its primary

purpose the gradual removal of internal border controls between signatory states for nationals of these states the schengen agreement is depicted as less concerned with free movement of people and more concerned with developing a legal basis for tighter border security against nationals from non signatory states the author states that the key purpose of the schengen agreement with respect to asylum seekers is the development of principles to determine which signatory state is responsible for the examination of particular asylum requests he asserts that these complex provisions will lengthen procedures the author

is also concerned that certain provisions of the agreement may be undemocratic introduce tighter controls on immigration than already practised by ec member states and that the agreement may be short sighted in light of future community immigration needs the paper analyses how articles 3 5 8 13 and 14 of the european convention may be invoked for the protection of asylum seekers and cites limitations imposed on the freedom of action of member states resulting from convention case law the author s conclusion is that the convention only retroactively effects member states that breach their humanitarian
