critical yet accessible this book provides an overview of the current debates about the europeanization of contract law charting the extent to which english contract law has been subject to this activity it is the ideal volume for readers unfamiliar with the subject who wish to understand the main issues quickly it examines a range of key developments including a string of directives adopted by the european union that touch on various aspects of consumer law recent plans for a european common frame of reference on european contract law bringing together advanced legal scholarship critically examining key developments in the field and considering the arguments for and against greater convergence in the area of contract law this is an excellent read for postgraduate students studying contract and or european law the book challenges the popular notion of a clash of cultures pitting muslim and non muslim europeans against one another the study finds instead vehement conflict among three longstanding european public philosophies liberalism nationalism and postmodernism the consequential differences of outlook are demonstrated in four policy areas 1 citizenship requirements 2 the headscarf debate 3 mosque state relations and 4 counter terrorism the book reaches three important conclusions first muslim europeans do not represent a monolithic anti western bloc a trojan horse within europe they vehemently disagree among themselves but along the same basic liberal nationalist and postmodern contours as non muslim europeans second ideological discord significantly contributes to policy messiness that is to inconsistent contradictory policies third both the discord and the messiness are remarkably similar from one european country to the next thereby casting doubt on the dominant theory in comparative migration studies that posits distinct national styles such as french republicanism german ethno nationalism and british multiculturalism this book challenges media celebrated evolutionary studies linking indo european languages to neolithic anatolia instead defending traditional practices in historical linguistics the seminal event of the 20th century the origins of the first world war have always been difficult to establish and have aroused deep controversy annika mombauer tracks the impassioned debates as they developed at critical points through the twentieth century the book focuses on the controversy itself rather than the specific events leading up to the war emotive and emotional from the very beginning of the conflict the debate and the passions aroused in response to such issues as the war guilt paragraph of the treaty of versailles are set in the context of the times in which they were proposed similarly the argument has been fuelled by concerns over the sacrifices that were made and the casualties that were suffered were they really justified human rights are much talked about and much written about in academic legal literature as well as in political and other social sciences and the general political debate this book argues that the universality of basic human rights is one of the values of the concept of rights it points out the risk of a certain inflation caused by the current habit of talking so much and so often about human rights and of using them as a basis for claims of various kinds these rights their understanding and interpretation may need to become more purist to ensure that universal human rights as a concept survive another chapter concentrates on the analysis of the frames of eu protected human rights from the perspective of effective implementation further the book not only deals with the complicated relations between the eu and international law but also seeks to show the horizontal effect to that end the fears and hopes of the member states and interest groups are categorized and commented on lastly the gaps in theory and practice are addressed current trends related to implementation are pointed out and suggestions are made concerning how to make the best out of the charter the public visibility of islam is becoming increasingly controversial throughout eminent local authors the chapters provide samples of new regional scholarship exploring these contested issues most of them translated into english for the first time and are prefaced with historiographical overviews addressing the state of the debate on these specific controversies these translations help bridge the language barriers that often separate scholarly traditions within southeast europe as well as scholars in southeast europe and english speaking academia this volume will enable readers to identify common patterns and influences that characterize the writing of it comes as no surprise that the crisis ultimately started to affect also the sociopolitical and institutional areas which is manifested in growing distrust of the europeans in the community institutions and liberal democracy this in turn resulted in widespread populism national and regional egoism and disintegration tendencies brexit is one of the first effects of the process along with the concerns that other members of the eu may take similar decisions which would be tantamount to its breakup in these circumstances convincing validation of further existence and development of the community requires great intellectual political and organisational effort and then finding effective channels to reach as broad as possible circle of responsible citizens with the proposals recommendations and ready application solutions to help them regain trust in the meaning of the european project and possibilities of functioning in the double national and european identity it would be perfect to make the mended eu more democratic i e to actively engage in the process the very europeans and not only techno and eurocrats one of the more interesting concepts at the moment seems to be the european added value which in a nutshell means a sum of extra benefits obtained on account of integration against the effects resulting from the national socio economic policy it is possible to
